What will happen on the night? Saturday 18th March 2017 Registration opens from 16.30pm at the Truro Cricket ground, please ensure you arrive no later than 18.00pm. You will need to bring your completed Registration Card and hand this in on arrival: you will be asked to sign a consent form.

You will attend a seminar at 18.30 for one hour in a private room away from the public. This training is based around psychological responses to extreme challenges and does not involve hypnosis. All fire walkers must attend this seminar and will be refused entry if all or part of the seminar is missed. Anyone suspected to have consumed alcohol will not be allowed to participate. There will be entertainment for those accompanying the firewalkers.

At approximately 19.30, you will be led outside to where the fire has been burning during the seminar. You will be asked to take your shoes and socks off and line up ready to walk. When the fire master is happy that the fire is safe to cross they will walk first.


